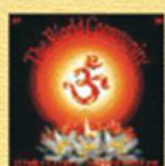

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योग विद्या का अवतरण क्रम

‘हिरण्यगर्भः समवर्तताग्रे’ वेदों के अनुसार हिरण्यगर्भ ईश्वर का नाम है। उसी नाम के आधार पर आचार्य हिरण्यगर्भ हुए जिन्होंने योग विद्या का प्रवर्तन किया। इसके पश्चात् उसी योग विद्या के विकास के लिए कपिल मुनि ने सांख्यदर्शन का निर्माण कर योग के मौलिक सिद्धान्तों की स्थापना की सांख्यदर्शन की उनके जीवनकाल में उच्चतम ख्याति हुई। कपिल मुनि ईश्वरीय अवतार माने जाते थे। कपिल ने अपनी माता देवहूति को योग का उपदेश दिया था इसका विशद वर्णन वेदव्यास ने भागवत महापुराण में की है। कपिल मुनि द्वारा निर्मित प्रकृति पुरुष के रहस्य के साथ महर्षि वेदव्यास ने योग विद्या के विस्तार में नया अध्याय जोड़ा ‘ब्रह्मसूत्र’ का निर्माण। उन्होंने योग तथा ब्रह्मविद्या का समन्वय किया। उसी समय से योग विद्या को ब्रह्मविद्या कहा जाने लगा। उसी योगधारा का विस्तार योगेश्वर श्रीकृष्ण ने गीता में किया। श्रीकृष्ण ने गीता में कपिल मुनि और वेदव्यास का नाम स्मरण किया है — ‘सिद्धानां कपिलो मुनिः’ कपिल को योगसिद्ध मुनि तथा वेदव्यास को ‘मुनीनामप्यहं व्यासः’ मैं मुनियों में वेदव्यास हूँ कहकर उन दोनों को योगाचार्य सिद्ध किया है। गीता में स्थान-स्थान पर योग के पूर्वज दोनों मुनियों के सांख्यदर्शन तथा ब्रह्मविद्या का योगविद्या के साथ सम्बन्ध दिखलाया है। श्रीकृष्ण के बाद महर्षि पतंजलि ने योग को चार पादों में विभक्त कर पातंजल योगसूत्र की रचना की।

हम कह सकते हैं कि कपिल-वेदव्यास तथा श्रीकृष्ण द्वारा वर्णित योग विद्या का यह संक्षिप्त संस्करण है। क्योंकि पतंजलि मुनि ने योग के सैद्धान्तिक विषयों का विस्तार हटाकर केवल योग विद्या के क्रियात्मक पक्ष का ही वर्णन किया। इसलिये योग विद्या का मौलिक तथा सैद्धान्तिक पक्ष अपरिचित सा हो गया। केवल अष्टांग योग पर ही सिमित (सीमित) गया। आज भी योग के रहस्य को जानने के लिए आचार्य हिरण्यगर्भ क पंचमहाभूत विद्या, कपिल के सांख्यदर्शन, वेदव्यास की ब्रह्मविद्या, कृष्ण के योगाधारित जीवन विद्या (गीता) की तीव्र आवश्यकता है, ताकि योग विद्या का धरातल सशक्त रहे।

योग विद्या के इतिहास क्रम में महर्षि वशिष्ठ तथा याज्ञवल्क्य मुनि तथा मनु का नाम स्मरणीय है जिन्होंने योगविद्या को राजर्षियों तक पहुंचाया। जो राजा योगविद्या पर आधारित दिनचर्या चलाते थे उन्हें राजर्षि कहा जाता था क्योंकि वह राजयोग के अनुयायी कहे जाते थे। आचार्य हिरण्यगर्भ के बाद योग के व्याख्याकार राजर्षि मनु थे जिन्होंने मनुस्मृति में योग का भी वर्णन किया। उनके बाद त्रेतायुग में राम को योगविद्या का उपदेश देने के लिए वशिष्ठ ने योगवाशिष्ठ ग्रन्थ की रचना की। श्रीकृष्ण और पतंजलि के अन्तराल में याज्ञवल्क्य तथा हेरण्ड आचार्य भी योग विद्या के संचालक माने जाते थे। महर्षि याज्ञवल्क्य ने योग को मानवधर्म की संज्ञा दी तथा आचार्य हेरण्ड ने हठयोग की व्याख्या की। योग की अध्ययन परम्परा में योगवाशिष्ठ तथा हठयोगप्रदीपिका ग्रन्थों का विशिष्ट महत्व है।

श्रीकृष्ण ने गीता उपदेश के पूर्व यह सिद्ध किया है कि (विवस्वान्) सूर्य से योग विद्या मनु ने ग्रहण करने के पश्चात् उसे इक्ष्वाकु जैसे राजाओं को प्रदान किया। वस्तुतः श्रीकृष्ण ने सूर्य शब्द से हिरण्यगर्भ का ही स्मरण किया है क्योंकि सूर्य समस्त हिरण्यों अर्थात् ज्योतियों का आधार है। सूर्य का पर्यायवाची ही हिरण्यगर्भ है। इसलिए आचार्य हिरण्यगर्भ ही योग प्रवर्तक प्रथम आचार्य माने जाते हैं।

योग के विश्वभर में प्रचार तथा उपादेयता को देखते हुए एक योगविश्वकोष (इन्स्टाइक्लोपीडिया ऑफ योग) के निर्माण की आवश्यकता है ताकि विश्वविद्यालयों में योगविद्या एक सक्षम विषय बन सके।

मैं योग कॉन्फेडरेशन ऑफ इण्डिया से जुड़े सभी लोगों को उनके सराहनीय कार्य के लिए हार्दिक शुभकामनाएं देता हूँ।

RESOLUTION

In the two days, Brain Storming Session (Seminar-cum-Workshop) of **Unmarketed and unraised holistic health issues/institutions** of the North Eastern Region organised by North Eastern Council in association with Yog Confederation of India and sponsored by Department of AYUSH, Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, it was resolved that :

1. The name of the movement should be changed from "Yog Vidya Jagriti Abhiyan" to **Holistic Health Movement**.
2. The proposal of Yog Confederation of India was accepted for implementation.
3. Holistic Health Movement has to be low cost, affordable, effective, accessible, transparent, scientific, examinable and implementable. This has to deal with the basic problems of any NER like TB, Cancer, AIDS, nutrition, liquor, drugs and should be peaceful, need based for mind, body and soul and should create awareness.
4. Movement should be followed with a missionary zeal by the volunteers and should create self employment, recognised by people, organise the unorganised, and have viable investment and policy package (SEVIFFP). It should further involve youths - mothers - society - community - spiritual institutions - clusters.
5. Movement should market the unmarketed and involve - organise, local, natural and medicinal practices and herbs. It should also involve local bodies and to begin with should identify easy, difficult, impossible, monitorable task with technology adaptation.
6. Movement should also have success parameters -
 - (a) HIppo - Hidden Investible Potential Powers of Organisation
 - (b) KIppo - Known Investible Potential Powers of Organisation
 - (c) TIppo - Threatening Investible Potential Powers of Organisation
 - (d) FIppo - Frightening Investible Potential Powers of Organisation
 - (e) GIppo - Globalisationally Investible Potential Powers of Organisation
7. In the movement we should try to search for aim of life, truth, mission and various principles of success should be incorporated. We should further define the role of various Ministries and organisations.
8. North East Mission on Volunteering and action (NEMOVA) should be formed and movement should be part of decentralised planning with IT.
9. All the sitting Governors and Chief Ministers of member States of NER i.e. Meghalaya, Assam, Manipur, Mizoram, Tripura, Arunachal Pradesh, Nagaland and Sikkim should be requested to become patrons of this holistic health movement for smooth functioning.
10. Secretary, NEC will be the Chairman of the movement and members have to be incorporated from the Yog Confederation of India, NEC and existing & supporting organisation which will function as central coordination committee.
11. In the first phase all the State Coordinators will enlist and network with present practitioners of various holistic sciences (traditional therapies) and they will be given recognition/award etc. An endeavour will be made to enlist people like Mr Naval Kishore Sharma who has been outstanding

in contribution propagating local ayurveda medicine. As recognition for the excellent work done he was given Padmashri by his Excellency, the President of India

12. 8 awareness/training camps will be organized in all the States of the region for which assistance will be taken from concerned Ministries like Department of AYUSH, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports, Ministry of Rural Development, Ministry of Panchayati Raj and State Governments. The people will be enlisted by district and State coordinators.
13. Diploma in Holistic Sciences will be launched in coordination with various Universities of the region for which 160 people (1 male and 1 female from each district of the region) will be selected and shall be put for training for 40 days (10 days in one stretch with a gap of three months each) at the centres fully funded by NEC like NEPA, Shillong; NERJWALM, Tezpur; RIMS in Manipur, RIPAN in Mizoram and this will be followed by 6 months internship. The trained holistic health practitioners will be attached to under-utilised and unutilised primary health centres subject to approval of the State Governments as a mean for self employment.
14. International Conference on Holistic Sciences will be organised wherein people practicing various holistic sciences will be called from all over the world for encouragement of the traditional therapies, breaking the ice of misconception of religion and promote tourism for the overall benefit and development of the region after scientifically validated and authenticated.
15. Primary Health Centres will be called as **Holistic Health Centres**. These centres will be an all embracing institutes to provide opportunity for development of sports together with other traditional and cultural practices for performance enhancement of sportsmen resorting to these practices. The vision is to produce Olympic Gold Medalist in the region.
16. For the implementation and funding of the above programme resolved to approach various concerned Ministries, State Governments and organisations like NHPC, United Nations, UNDP, The Japan Foundation, Asian Development Bank, Afro-Asian Rural Development Organisation, WHO, NABARD, World Bank etc. Agencies like IFAD for sponsorship.
17. While formulating programme for the movement, care will be taken to see that the peoples' choices of therapies in a particular centre are considered. Hon'ble Minister of DONER be request to coordinate this programme.
18. Shri Ajay Kumar Gupta, District Coordinator NYK, Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports has been asked to coordinate with various district coordinators of NYK of the region to solicit support and viewpoint in this regard. These coordinators will be requested to approach the Blocks, Panchayats and Villages for the implementation of this movement along with Youth Development Centres.
19. Movement will encourage non permanent staff, volunteerism and will identify disease free villages and link up with development process. Further, ex-defence personnel and civil servants will also be approached for their support and involvement.
20. Resolved to request Government of India to honour healthy villages, people, NGOs and research projects extensively engaged in the process of Holistic Health Movement. To increase understanding and promote awareness literature in local language for the benefit of the local people will be made to facilitate better coordination and implementation.

 6. Programme will be organized all over nation
 7. Conduct Yoga courses in other States/UTs
 8. Organize National Yog Camps for selection for World Yoga Competitions.
 9. Launch a course in Diploma in Holistic Sciences incorporating traditional therapies. Details of the same (attached with the handouts).
- The participants' reaction to the proposed movement is outlined as under:-

MINUTES OF THE BRAIN STORMING SESSION (SEMINAR - CUM - WORKSHOP) OF UNMARKETED AND UNRAISED HOLISTIC HEALTH ISSUES/ INSTITUTIONS

- The Session was held on 11th & 12th February, 2005 at All Saints' Cathedral Hall, Shillong.
- Organized by North Eastern Council, Govt. of India, Shillong in Collaboration with Yoga Confederation of India and Sponsored by Department of AYUSH, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India
- The Seminar was inaugurated by Dr. A.Sethi, Vice-President, Y.C.I. and was presided over by Mr. R.P. Kharpuria, Director (E&M) NEC. The other dignitaries on the day were:- Col Vijay Mohan, Dr. S. Shekhar, Dr. Pradeep Sharma, Mr. Raja Hala, Coordinator Y.C.I., Acharya Satyendra Narayan Singh and Mr. Vijay Tiwari, General Secretary, Y.C.I.
- The Session began at 10.50 AM
- In his introductory remark, Mr. Kharpuria explained the reasons which prompted the NEC to take initiative in this respect. He said the main objectives of the programme are to create awareness among the community about the preventive, curative, and promotive aspects of the Indian Systems of medicines and Homoeopathy. In the region there are several hundreds local practitioners who in their own way had contributed substantially in terms of providing medical health facilities to the people using local herbs and plants. Time has come to accord recognition and to coordinate to see that the system is developed and promoted for the benefit of the people of the region. He requested the participants to proactively involve in the deliberation.
- Mr. Vijay Tiwari explained the need of Yog Vidya Jagriti Abhiyan and its first step towards the Nation wide recognition and absorption up to the Panchayats with the help of NEC, Department of AYUSH, Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Government of India, Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Ministry of Rural Development & Ministry of Panchayati Raj. An attempt will be made to initiate action for this movement in the country as a whole and subsequently world wide through networking with different Embassies.
- Dr. Sethi Vice-President of Y.C.I. in his inaugural address briefly touched upon the need of Yog Vidya Jagriti Abhiyan in line to the various holistic approaches.
- The attending officials and members were asked to introduce themselves.
- Mr. Rakesh Singh from Mumbai emphasized the need to incorporate different therapies in the Holistic Science. It was resolved that steps need to be taken to obtain:-
 - ❖ Recommendation from the University for Recognition of the Diploma in Holistic Sciences
 - ❖ To promote Marketing of Yoga/holistic sciences (traditional & regional therapies)

- ❖ Propagation of Yog needs to be accompanied with relevant philosophy
- ❖ Yoga should be propagated as a modern trend with ancient foundation
- ❖ Workshops be conducted for educating the general public and making awareness about the utility of different therapies.

- Then presentation was made by Mr. Vishwajeet, NSS volunteer suggesting steps for correct interpretation of Yog
- Presentation was made by Shri Khagen Kalita, on the philosophy of Yoga and its corresponding benefit.
- Presentation of a 10 day camp of Yog held in Sainik School, Goalpara & (a CD of the same was made before the audience)
- Then we have a presentation by Dr. Pradeep Sharma, President, Su Jok Acupuncture Association of India. He spoke on the benefit of this Korean therapy for different types of ailments.
- Dr. Som Shekhar highlighted the close relation of Yoga and Ayurveda
- Mr. Shushil Kumar as a Chairman of the technical session expressed the need for better interpretation of Yoga. He further suggested the printing of literature to educate the people.
- Groups were formed on the basis of the State wherein State coordinators were to be selected followed by the district coordinators
